1.1.4 Qualifying Requirements

- a. General requirements of the bidder from country sharing the land border with India.
- i. Order No: F. No.6/18/2019-PPD dated: 23-July-2020 from Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, mentions that any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in any procurement whether of goods, services (including consultancy services and non-consultancy services) or works (including turnkey projects) only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as specified in the order.

22.1.2 “Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India” for the purpose of the order means-

- a) An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- b) A subsidiary of an entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- c) An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
- d) An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country; or
- e) An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
- f) A natural person who is a citizen of such a country; or
- g) A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above

The above-mentioned order shall be applicable to this tender. The bidder shall carefully go through the above-mentioned order and ensure its eligibility in accordance of the same. Bidder should refer to above mentioned order for clarification over definitions and clauses as applicable.

22.1.3 The bidder shall submit a Self-Declaration regarding “Restrictions on procurement from a Bidder of a country which shares a land border with India” as per Annexure ‘B’ of this section.

22.1.4 Make In India

All bidders who are participating in the tender have to use EVSE /Battery swapping equipments which are being manufactured in India in line with Govt. of India ‘s policy to promote manufacturing in India .The bidders will have to submit a certificate confirming the same .They will comply to the requirements of Ministry of Power’s order No. A-1/2021-FSC-Part(5) dated 16.11.2021.
